☒ Other: If either car which is subject to this decision makes a pit stop which is intended to be below the prohibited pit stop range as confirmed in Stewards Bulletin #6 and Article 44 of the California 8 Hours 2018 Sporting Regulations, at the commencement of that stop the car, once stationary, must be held in parc ferme for a minimum of 5 seconds. During this parc ferme period, no equipment or personnel (save those permitted by Article 125) are allowed in the working area and no contact is to be made with the car by any personnel. If a driver change is to be made, the exiting driver cannot make any actions to exit the car during the parc ferme period. The prohibited pit stop range is not amended by this decision.
